




Tasks for Key Stage 1: Chestnut and Elm Class - Mrs Dowell and Mrs Richards

<p>Mathletics: all children have their own log-ins either in their reading diary or homework books. You will have work assigned weekly. I can see who has been logging into Mathletics – Well done!</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths Game</u></b></p> <p>Make Ten or Twenty Solitaire(1-2 players) This game is traditionally played as solitaire, but can easily be modified for two players.</p> <p>Deal the cards into three rows of five face up, the rest are in a pile face down to the side. If you can add two cards that equal the sum of 10 or 20 depending on which you are playing, you collect the cards. New cards are dealt into the holes that were left from the cards that were picked up. What makes a healthy sandwich or lunch?</p>	<p>1. Use old plastic bottles to make a game of skittles.
