Aspiration

Each year group has a progression of skills in map work and they are encouraged to use different types of maps and atlases, which will help them in their adult lives. The children at Crowmoor are exposed to a varied Geography curriculum which is designed to inspire and encourage children to flourish.

Healthy Lifestyle

Our Geography Curriculum at Crowmoor gives children the opportunity to access the outdoors and experience nature around us. We have a diverse outdoor area available for all pupils. Teachers and pupils understand the benefits of the outdoors for a person's physical and emotional wellbeing. Children are exposed to the wide world during their Geography lessons and they begin to understand that your geographical area can affect a person's lifestyle.
