





Winter Holiday Fun in Shropshire

Have fun with your friends, learn new skills, gain confidence and get involved!

Shropshire Council is working with local schools, voluntary and community organisations, and childcare providers to run an exciting holiday programme this winter, Shropshire HAF (Holiday Activities and Food).

There are free places available on the programme for children and young people aged 4, (in reception class or equivalent), to 16, who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals and for those who have been referred onto HAF by a professional. (See page 5 for more information about referrals).

During 19 to 23 December 2022, children and young people are invited to take part in a range of fun activities, happening at 43 venues from across the county. Use this Guide to find out what activities will suit your child/ren. There is something on offer for everyone, including sports, arts, cooking, forest schools and other exciting opportunities. Free nutritious meals will be provided at each session, as well as information on nutrition to benefit the whole family.

Booking:

Following feedback about the centralised HAF booking system used over the summer, all bookings for the Winter/Christmas holidays will be made directly with the organisations running the holiday clubs. Apologies for any inconvenience this may cause.

Your child/ren will be given a HAF Information leaflet via their school. The leaflet includes a unique code. You will need to use this code when booking.

The unique code entitles your child/ ren to attend 4 sessions of free holiday activity in Shropshire during the week of the 19 to 23 December 2022.

Please don't use this code to book onto more than 4 sessions of activity or to book onto multiple programmes of activity with different providers, happening at the same time, it won't be valid.

This code is individual to your child/s school and is not transferable to other children.

What You Need To Do:

- Use this Guide to find which holiday club is suitable for your child/ren.
- 2. Book onto activity by contacting the organisation running the holiday club direct, using the contact details in this Guide.
- 3. When making a booking, please quote your unique HAF Code (see information leaflet issued by your child/rens school or through professional referral).
- 4. If your child/ren has SEND (Special Educational Needs & Disabilities) or receives any extra help at school, before booking onto activity, please contact the holiday club to discuss your child/s needs. (Please see page 7 for more information about SEND).
- 5. Any queries you have about your booking or the activities on offer, please contact the organisation running the holiday club directly.

How do I know if my child/ren is able to access HAF activity for free?

There are free places available on the programme for children and young people aged 4 (who are in reception class or equivalent) to 16, who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals.

Professional referrals onto the HAF programme for children & young people who are not eligible for benefits related free school meals.

There are a limited number of free places available for children and young people on the Shropshire HAF Winter programme 2022, who are not in receipt of benefits-related free school meals but meet a wider eligibility criterion.

These children and young people can be referred onto the programme by a professional.

Please note, these referred places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis by the Shropshire HAF Co-Ordinators.

Shropshire Council makes the final decision on which children and young people should benefit from the flexible funding element of the HAF programme.

The criteria for non-free school meal children and young people participating in the programme are being reviewed for 2023.

Paid Places & Longer Activity Sessions

Some of the holiday clubs also include paid spaces for children and young people who are not eligible for the HAF programme. These have been highlighted in the Guide. Please contact the organisation running the club direct to make a booking.

Some of the holiday programmes are subsidising the HAF programme and are running for longer than the HAF funded 4 hours a day. Please contact activity provider for more information.

SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) or children and young people who receive any extra help at school

A number of providers are running activity, with places available for children and young people with SEND. These places are at settings offering mainstream programmes with a range of children and young people. These have been highlighted in the Guide.

Before booking onto any activity, please contact the provider to discuss your child/s needs.

1:1 Support:

If your child/ren requires 1:1 support at school (mainstream or specialist) or in any other educational setting, they will also need 1:1 support to access the HAF holiday clubs (highlighted in the guide as offering SEND places.) Currently, the HAF programme is unfortunately unable to fund 1:1 support - any child needing 1:1 support to access the programme would need to have 1:1 funding and support in place before attending.


If you have funding in place and need help sourcing a PA to support your child/ren to take part in HAF activities, some of the activity providers can help. For a fee they may be able to provide a member of staff to offer your child/ren 1:1 support. Please ask the organisations direct about availability and costs. As mentioned above HAF is not able to fund this 1:1 support.
