Art and Design

Chestnut will study the work of artists who mix primary colours to make secondary colours, use white to mix tints and black to mix shades. They will make observational drawings.

English - Writing

Using their reading text as inspiration, pupils will write setting & character descriptions, letters, diary entries and short narratives. They will also learn to write poetry.

History

Children will uncover the history of Mary Anning 'The Fossil Hunter' and the real life super hero, Grace Darling.

Personal, Social, Health, Economic

We will explore ways to live a healthy lifestyle, manage feelings and to understand what makes us unique.

Computing

Pupils will learn to use a keyboard to create, manipulate and edit text. They will begin to use animation software.

Design and Technology

Food is the focus next term. We will grow some fruit and vegetables to use in designing healthy dips and dippers from around the world.
